50% of business leaders say hiring challenges impact their ability to operate at full capacity



Compared with a year ago, have overall economic conditions in the Harrisburg Region improved, remained the same or worsened?






Economic Sentiment

During the next 12 months, do you expect the overall economic conditions in the Harrisburg Region will be better, about the same or worse than now?






Revenue Projections

Do you expect your company's profitability to improve, remain about the same or worsen during the next 12 months?






Job Growth

Do you expect your company's total number of employees will increase, remain about the same or decrease during the next 12 months?






Hiring Landscape

Are hiring challenges impacting your ability to operate your business at full capacity?






Hiring Landscape

4 in 5 business leaders did not experience consistent or increasing hiring challenges.


Is your company finding it easier or more difficult to fill job openings than it was 12 months ago?

4 out of 5 local business leaders have challenges hiring employees.






Access to Capital

What is the primary obstacle your business faces when seeking capital?





How are supply chain issues affecting your business as compared to 12 months ago?






Childcare






